Preface

North Bengal St. Xavier's College is the third higher educational institution established by the Darjeeling Jesuits of North Bengal, its parent body which is part of the international Roman Catholic Jesuit Order. The college was established in 2007 at a temporary building in Matigara, Darjeeling District before shifting a year later to the present location at Balaigaach village under Rajganj Block of Dist Jalpaiguri, West Bengal. In 2015 the college was given permanent affiliated by the University of North Bengal. In the year 2017, the college was recognized with 2 (b) and 12 (f) by the 1956 Act of University Grant Commission (UGC). The Motto of the college is "Gyan Vigyan Vimukte" meaning 'Knowledge and freedom from darkness'.

North Bengal St. Xavier's College is a co-educational Institution which offers the following Undergraduate Course courses: Honours in English, History, Geography, Political Science, Sociology, Botany, Computer Science, Microbiology, Zoology, B.Com (Accountancy/Management), Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.), Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.), B.Sc (General/Programme) in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, and B.Com (General/Programme). In 2016, a City Campus at Siliguri was started that offers morning classes in B.Com and BBA catering chiefly to students engaged in part-time jobs or assisting in family businesses. All these are offered as self-financed courses.

Apart from the academic activities, students and staff also get opportunities to participate in various co-curricular activities like, National Service Scheme (NSS), Social Service Cell, Nature Club, AICUF, Women's Cell, National Cadets Corps (NCC only for Girls from 2020), Career Guidance Cell, Research Cell, Music Club, Games & Sports, Cultural activities, etc. The College is going for its 1st Cycle of NAAC accreditation in 2021.

The college functions according to its Perspective Plan, prepared at suitable intervals by revisiting its priorities, objectives including vision and mission and according to the demands and changing signs of the time. The present Perspective Plan (2017-2024) is the one that the college has made as a roadmap for the growth of the institution in accordance with the avowed vision and mission of the college. The plan envisages to enhance academic quality and standard, accompany students, staff and other stakeholders in their spiritual and other human growth and create opportunities for students to actively participate in the community service and become promoters of environmental.

Inputs from Management policies, goals and objectives of the institution, inputs from the stakeholders including industries are considered as a base for the preparation of the perspective plan. In the year 2017, the institution went through a process of discernment and deliberation among Jesuit Fathers, the Governing Body members, staff and stakeholders regarding the preparation of the perspective plan. Accordingly, North Bengal St. Xavier's College, Rajganj (& Siliguri campus) has prepared a perspective plan for the period 2017-2024.
